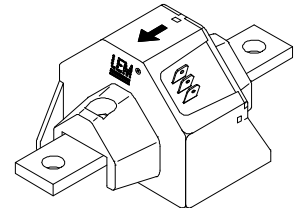


Current Transducer LA 205-T/SP6

$$I_{PN} = 200 \text{ A}$$

For the electronic measurement of currents : DC, AC, pulsed..., with a galvanic isolation between the primary circuit (high power) and the secondary circuit (electronic circuit).

- Railway equipment.

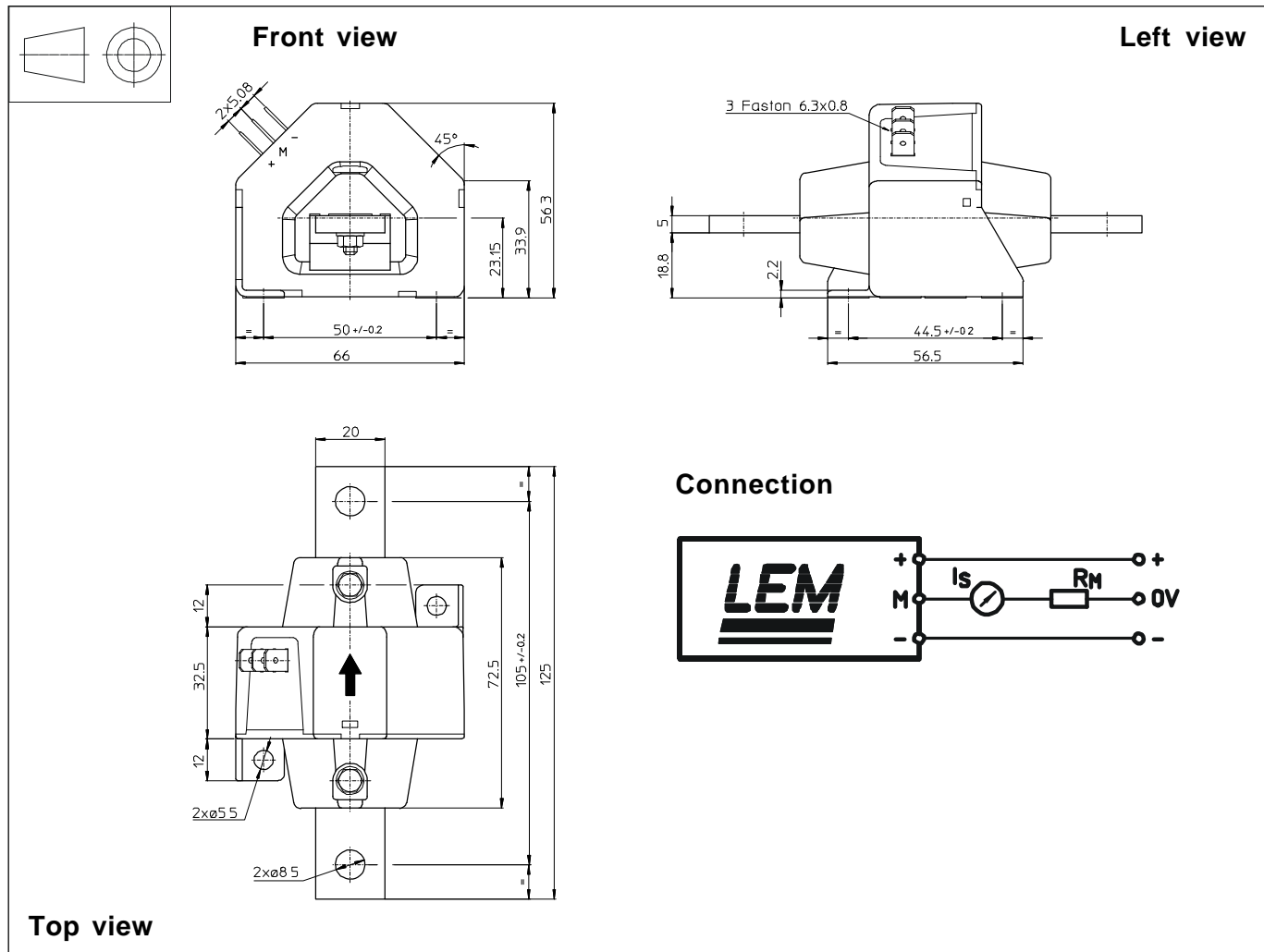
Advantages

Mechanical characteristics

- General tolerance ± 0.5 mm
- Fastening
 - By the transducer
 - 2 holes $\varnothing 5.5$ mm
 - 2 M5 steel screws
 - Fastening torque
 - 4 Nm or 2.95 Lb.-Ft.
 - Or
 - By the primary bar
 - 2 holes $\varnothing 8.5$ mm
- Connection of secondary
 - Faston 6.3 x 0.8 mm

Remarks

- I_s is positive when I_p flows in the direction of the arrow.
- Temperature of the primary conductor should not exceed 100°C.
